An Inspirational Presence...

Di Barrong has been an accountant, an insurance agent, an office manager and a 'Jill-of-all-trades' assistant. She went back to college with her son and earned a BA in Business management in 1997. Di retired from her job at Landmark Designs and left all that behind about five years ago. She and her husband, Jim, of almost 44 years have two sons and seven grandchildren. She's an avid quilter, loves old cars, likes to camp and makes time with each of her grandkids. She is the epitome of what active retirement should look like. So, where did she get the full-time energy she puts into Bags of Love?

She tells her story best. Every time with the enthusiasm and commitment she brings to this amazing organization.

"A number of years ago a dream began for me that I needed to find a way to help the children I observed being placed into foster home care. They came with next to nothing in the way of possessions. After ten years of work, I was

approached by a group called 'It's My Very Own' with an idea I felt was the best solution. After some research though, it was clear that the idea needed to be revised to fit the needs of our area. In 2008 Bags of Love was incorporated and then granted non-profit status 501(c)(3) in October of that year.

"After our bags were rejected by the Department of Human Services - they used bags they got from a church. We began to contact other local agencies and the picture we got from them was that there was a need for as many as 300 bags a month. Each bag represents approximately \$100 in donations of items and monetary contributions. With the support of numerous volunteers, Bags of Love, manages to put bags into the hands of children who need them."

The history of the organization is backed by Di. She's the total spokeswoman, Board Chair, Executive Director and full-time presence in the building now occupied by Bags of Love for less than one year. She has recruited Board Members and volunteers to do much of the ongoing work. But, ultimately, she still makes it happen. Not one penny has ever gone into the pockets of anyone volunteering to work at Bags of Love. It is what the name implies...a work of loving hands and hearts. There are times when the need is so much more than the \$\$ in the account. She trusts a blessing will occur and with the help of volunteers and generous people it usually does without having to dip into her own pockets...but not always. With an open heart and a joyous smile she welcomes anyone who wishes to help. She is not jealous of anyone who would suggest a better way to raise money and she never hesitates to make the time to speak about her beloved 'project'.

She tells her story best and her generous spirit and warmth comes through when she talks about **Bags of Love**; where it came from, why it survives and what it needs, now.

She says it best... **"It's all about the kids!"**
