



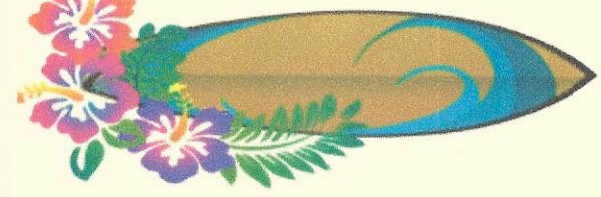
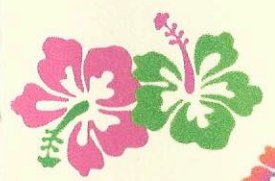
Somewhere over the rainbow

 Oh why, oh why can't I?

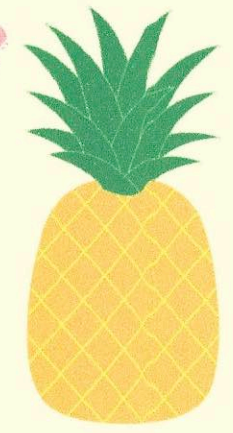
Well I see trees of green and red roses too,

First Vice President - Jill Rankin

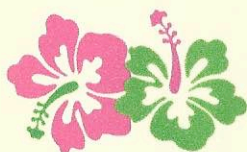
